

Chinese Culture on the Road

Objective

Chinese Culture on Road is a one-day mini cultural fair to promote multicultural awareness, increase the understanding and appreciation of Chinese culture, and stimulate interest in Chinese language study amongst New Zealand school students in Christchurch. Chinese cultural activities can include Chinese painting, Chinese calligraphy, and martial arts and cooking dumplings. Chinese Culture on the Road can be provided according to the specific interests of the host school. Three teachers from the Confucius Institute at the University of Canterbury (CIUC) will provide the activities.



Format

Chinese Culture on Road can take different form: it could be hour-long class visits or half-day or full-day cultural fairs. We are only able to provide this service on **Fridays**. Chinese Culture on the Road could be incorporated into pre-existing school open days or international awareness days. It could also be organised to coincide with a traditional Chinese festivals such as the Chinese Spring Festival or the Dragon Boat Festival, etc.
